In an effort to be proactive and help ensure the health and safety of children, families and all those that work with First 5 Yuba, we are recommending guidelines set forth by Governor Gavin Newsom and Centers for Disease Control (CDC) officials in order to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 in our community.

Those guidelines include the cancellation or postponement of mass gatherings of 50 people or more as well as smaller gatherings held in venues that do not allow for social distancing of six feet per person. Please note these guidelines are fluid and may change.

The safety and welfare of children and families we serve will always be our utmost concern and we are working alongside our local Yuba-Sutter Public Health Officials to help mitigate and keep the spread of this virus to a minimum among our Counties.

Both First 5 Yuba and Sutter County Children and Families Commission will be hosting a Call-in Center for families needing support, information or access to local resources such as childcare, food assistance and other general family needs.
