COVID-19 Preventive Strategies:

Health Checks

conducted at each shelter and day center to limit exposure of people experiencing symptoms

- Screened 192
- Referred for Testing 5
- Quarantined 2
- Tested Positive 0

Highest Risk Individuals

prioritized for motel rooms and shelter beds

- Age 65+ Placed in Motels 75
- Medically Vulnerable Placed in Shelter 30
- Permanently Housed 45

Meals, Outreach, and Education

provided for unsheltered individuals at a single location in both counties, and at-risk individuals who are sheltering in place

- Yuba County 8196
- Sutter County 5112
- Sheltering in Place 7729

Revised Shelter and Day Center Protocols

- Tele case-management
- Limit common area population
- Meals delivered or to go
- Education on shelter in place
- Transportation for housing only
- Daily disinfection routines
- Designated quarantine space
- Client screening interviews

- Bottled Water
- Gloves
- Gowns
- Paper Towels
- Snacks to-go
- Disinfectant Wipes
- Bleach
